

Commentary on Candidate 3

The evidence for this candidate has achieved the following marks for each *stage* of this Course Assessment.

Question 1(a) Action Plan

The candidate was awarded **5 marks** because the description of the chosen individual was clear with more than 4 relevant points of explanation. Full answer.

Question 1(b)

The candidate was awarded **2 marks** because each stage was given a timeline with a short breakdown detailed.

Question 1(c)

The candidate was awarded **3 marks** as each chosen source gave an accurate point of explanation linking to the issues described in 1(a) and the individual. Each source of information was referenced.
