

Compare the observations of these two candidates, both commenting on an extract from a letter to the editor of the *Manchester Guardian* in 1937:

Example 6

Source C is from a letter to the editor of the *Manchester Guardian* and is from the 24th June 1937, almost a year after the beginning of the Spanish Civil War.

Example 7

The source is a primary source published 24th June 1937, during the 3 year war, in the *Manchester Guardian* newspaper. Its purpose as a letter is to reflect the opinions of those on the Republican side, telling of the danger and destruction taking place and conveying these ideas to the British public to change their opinion in favour of intervention.

Though both of these contain some of the same information, the first makes no evaluative comment, so can receive little credit, whereas the second contains interpretation of the provenance of the source, laying the foundation for a potentially good answer.
