Question 13 (A)	<p>Marks were awarded for the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◆ Benefits from free movement of labour – creativity ◆ Foreign labour willing to occupy low paid manual jobs ◆ No trade barriers with rest of the EU ◆ EU funding channelled into local economy ◆ Foreign migrants pay tax helping reduce budget deficit ◆ Migrants may cause unemployment to UK workers ◆ Non-membership could hinder ability to influence economic policies ◆ UK forced to pay proportion of GDP into European funds <p>Productivity point was not credited.</p>	8/10 marks
Question 13 (B)	<p>Marks were awarded for the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◆ Some Eurozone countries still struggling with post-2008 crash ◆ Greece example ◆ Different rates of unemployment – Croatia / Spain ◆ Reduction in aggregate demand <p>Euro devaluation point not credited.</p> <p>Low global demand point not credited.</p>	4/8 marks
Question 13 (C)	<p>Marks were awarded as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◆ Quantitative Easing point fully developed (2 marks) ◆ Helicopter money – advantages/disadvantages considered (2 marks) ◆ Forward guidance fully evaluated / considered (2 marks) ◆ Can introduce debt relief for those countries in debt (1 mark) 	7/7 marks
