

## **Candidate 3 – Part A: Historical Issues**

The evidence for this candidate was placed within the following mark ranges for each question of this course assessment component.

### **Question 52: To what extent did the status of women change as a result of Nazi policies between 1933 and 1939? (25 marks)**

#### ***Structure***

The candidate's evidence was placed within the 13-14 mark range because the structure of the essay displays a basic organisation which includes a relevant functional introduction and a conclusion which makes an overall judgement on the issue.

#### ***Thoroughness/relevance of information and approach***

The candidate's evidence was placed within the 13-14 mark range because the candidate's treatment of the issue shows sufficient relevant knowledge which reflects a basic understanding of the issue.

#### ***Analysis/evaluation/line of argument Historical sources/interpretations***

The candidate's evidence was placed within the 13-14 mark range because the candidate makes an attempt to answer the evaluative aims of the question and analyse the issues involved. This, however, is not deep or sustained.

#### ***Historical sources/interpretations***

The candidate's evidence was placed within the 10-12 mark range because there is no discernible reference to historical works.
