	<p>Pliny says "danger" which shows the urgency of the situation - the people are at risk.</p>	
	<p>Pliny says "massive tremors" to show the extent of how badly the earth is shaking. This creates urgency by showing the reader the level of danger being caused by the natural disaster.</p>	
	<p>Pliny also says "fear". This shows that the people were panicking and shows the urgency just to escape by them.</p>
