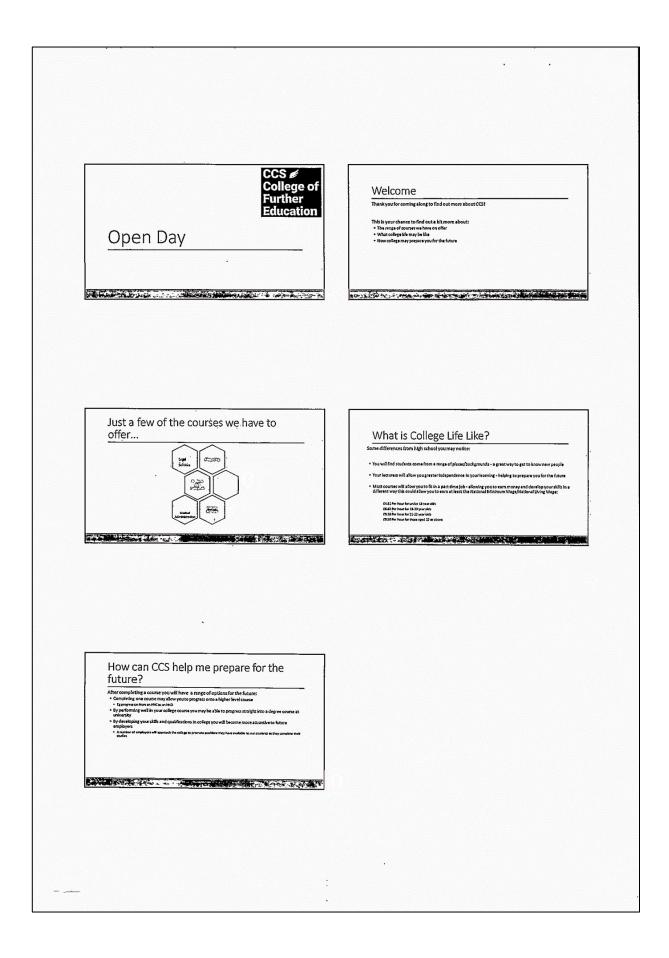

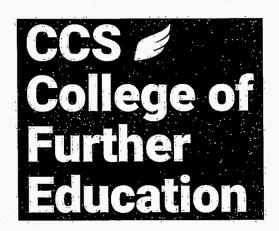

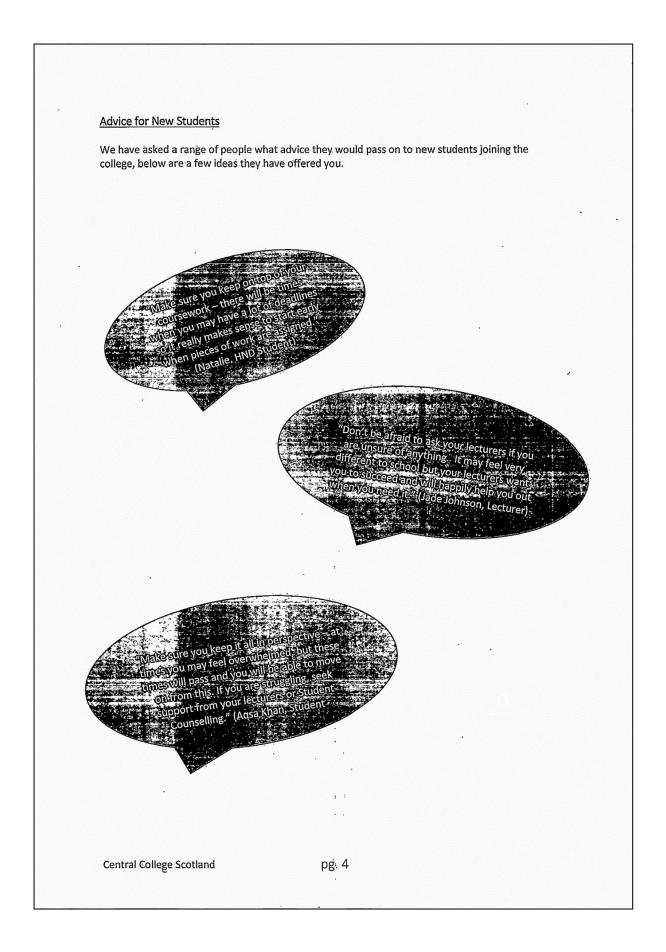
You can apply to SAAS based on residency. To meet their general residence conditions, you must:
