

# Commentary on candidate evidence

The candidate evidence has achieved the following marks for each question of this question paper.

## Question 3

### Candidate 1

The candidate was awarded **3 marks**.

The candidate was not awarded mark 1 as they have incorrectly calculated the taxable income.

The candidate was awarded mark 2 for calculating the tax for the starter rate correctly.

The candidate was awarded mark 3 as a follow through, because they correctly calculated the tax for the basic rate based on their previously calculated taxable income.

The candidate was awarded mark 4 as a follow through, because they correctly calculated the net monthly salary based on their previously working.

### Candidate 2

The candidate was awarded **3 marks**.

The candidate was not awarded mark 1 as they have not calculated the taxable income.

The candidate was awarded mark 2 for calculating the tax for the starter rate correctly.

The candidate was awarded mark 3 as a follow through, because they correctly calculated the tax for the basic rate based on their previous working.

The candidate was awarded mark 4 as a follow through, because they calculated the net monthly salary correctly based on their previously working.

## Candidate 3

### Question 5(a)(i)

The candidate was awarded **1 mark**.

The candidate was awarded mark 1 for a correct histogram.

### Question 5(a)(ii)

The candidate was awarded **1 mark**.

The candidate was awarded mark 2 for accurately describing the distribution.

### Question 5(a)(iii)

The candidate was awarded **1 mark**.

The candidate was awarded mark 3 for generating the median.

The candidate was not awarded mark 4 because they have not explicitly identified the measure of location.

### Question 5(b)

The candidate was awarded **1 mark**.

The candidate was awarded mark 5 because they have stated a valid reason.

## Candidate 4

### Question 5(a)(i)

The candidate was awarded **0 marks**.

The candidate was not awarded mark 1 because the last bin is missing.

See Note 2 of the marking instructions.

### Question 5(a)(ii)

The candidate was awarded **0 marks**.

The candidate was not awarded mark 2 because the statistical statement is incorrect.

## Candidate 5

### Question 5(a)(i)

The candidate was awarded **1 mark**.

The candidate was awarded mark 1 for providing a correct histogram.

### Question 5(a)(ii)

The candidate was awarded **0 marks**.

The candidate was not awarded mark 2 because the statistical statement is incorrect.

### Question 5(a)(iii)

The candidate was awarded **1 mark**.

The candidate was awarded mark 3 as a follow through mark based on their previous statement.

The candidate was not awarded mark 4 because they have not explicitly identified the measure of location.

### Question 5(b)

The candidate was awarded **0 marks**.

The candidate was not awarded mark 5 because they have not stated a valid reason.

## Question 6

### Candidate 6

The candidate was awarded **1 mark**.

The candidate was awarded mark 1 for accumulating the value of the initial deposit using method 2.

The candidate was not awarded mark 2, the bonus was not calculated correctly.

The candidate was not awarded mark 3 as there is no attempt.

The candidate was not awarded mark 4 because the working has been eased.

### Candidate 7

The candidate was awarded **3 marks**.

The candidate was awarded mark 1 for accumulating the value of the initial deposit, using method 1.

The candidate was not awarded mark 2, the bonus was not calculated correctly; it has been calculated at the end of month 1.

The candidate was awarded mark 3 as a follow through mark because the multiplier for interest was identified.

The candidate was awarded mark 4 as a follow through mark, the final balance is consistent with the incorrect bonus.

### Candidate 8

The candidate was awarded **2 marks**.

See COR Candidate A.

The candidate was awarded mark 1 and 2 for accumulating the bonus at the start of month 1 leading to an answer.

## Candidate 9

### Question 7(a)

The candidate was awarded **2 marks**.

The candidate was awarded mark 1 because they have stated the correct probability of a delay.

The candidate was awarded mark 2 because they correctly calculated the expected cost of the delay.

### Question 7(b)

The candidate was awarded **0 marks**.

The candidate was not awarded mark 3 because they have an incorrect calculation for the expected cost with control measure 2.

### Question 7(c)

The candidate was awarded **1 mark**.

The candidate was awarded mark 4 as a follow through mark, a valid explanation based on their working has been given.

## Candidate 10

### Question 7(a)

The candidate was awarded **2 marks**.

The candidate was awarded mark 1 because they have stated the correct probability of a delay.

The candidate was awarded mark 2 because they calculated correctly the expected cost of the delay.

### **Question 7(b)**

The candidate was awarded **1 mark**.

The candidate was awarded mark 3 because they have a correct calculation for the expected cost with control measure 2.

### **Question 7(c)**

The candidate was awarded **1 mark**.

The candidate was awarded mark 4 because they provided a valid explanation.

## Question 8(a)

### Candidate 11

The candidate was awarded **1 mark**.

The candidate was not awarded mark 1 because the loan amount entered in cells C8 and F17 is incorrect.

The candidate was not awarded mark 2 because they have an incorrect formula/no ROUND function.

The candidate was awarded mark 3 as a follow through mark, the schedule has been completed and has the correct value in cell C53.

The candidate was not awarded mark 4 because cell F53 is not equal to 0. See Note 4 of the marking instructions.

The candidate was not awarded mark 5 because the annual and monthly rates are inconsistent.

### Candidate 12

The candidate was awarded **2 marks**.

The candidate was not awarded mark 1 because the loan amount entered in cells C8 and F17 is incorrect.

The candidate was not awarded mark 2 because they have no ROUND function in their formula.

The candidate was not awarded mark 3 because the value in cell C53 is incorrect.

The candidate was awarded mark 4 because the cell F53 is equal to 0.

The candidate was awarded mark 5 as a follow through mark, the monthly and annual rates are consistent.

## Question 8(b)

### Candidate 13

The candidate was awarded **0 marks**.

The candidate was not awarded mark 6 because there is no mention of financial protection or accident. See Note 2(a) of the marking instructions.

## Question 8(c)

### Candidate 14

The candidate was awarded **2 marks**.

The candidate was awarded mark 7 because the correct effective monthly interest rate has been calculated.

The candidate was not awarded mark 8 because the formulae in cells C20 and E20 are incorrect.

The candidate was not awarded mark 9 because the amendment is incorrect and in row 23 instead of row 24.

The candidate was awarded mark 10 as a follow through mark, cell C16 is equal to cell C31.

### Candidate 15

The candidate was awarded **4 marks**.

The candidate was awarded mark 7 because the correct effective monthly interest rate has been calculated.

The candidate was awarded mark 8 because the formulae in cells C20, D20 and E20 are correct.

The candidate was awarded mark 9 because the amendment is correct (cell C24).

The candidate was awarded mark 10 because they calculated the correct balance before the monthly payment is made (cell C16).

## Question 9(a)

### Candidate 16

The candidate was awarded **1 mark**.

The candidate was awarded mark 1 because they have given a valid explanation with reference to questions 1 and 3.

### Candidate 17

The candidate was awarded **0 marks**.

The candidate was not awarded mark 1 because they made no reference to the inter quartile range.

## Question 9(b)(ii)

### Candidate 18

The candidate was awarded **0 marks**.

The candidate was not awarded mark 3, because they did not include 'difference in the mean' in their hypothesis.

## Question 9(b)(iii)

### Candidate 19

The candidate was awarded **2 marks**.

The candidate was awarded mark 4 because they have correctly interpreted the p value.

The candidate was awarded mark 5 as a follow through mark, the statement is consistent with their hypothesis.

## Question 10(a)

### Candidate 20

The candidate was awarded **2 marks**.

The candidate was awarded mark 1 because they have started the graph at 4.

The candidate was awarded mark 2 because they drew a continuous straight line with a positive gradient.

The candidate was not awarded mark 3 because they did not stop the graph at 28.

## Question 10(b)(ii)

### Candidate 21

The candidate was awarded **0 marks**.

The candidate was not awarded mark 5 because they have not included the depth in their answer.

## Question 10(c)

### Candidate 22

The candidate was awarded **1 mark**.

The candidate was awarded mark 6 because they have identified the correct graph.

The candidate was not awarded mark 7 because they have only referred to the time taken to fill the container. See Note 2 of the marking instructions.

### Candidate 23

The candidate was awarded **0 marks**.

The candidate was not awarded mark 6 because they have not identified the correct graph.

The candidate was not awarded mark 7. See Note 1 of the marking instructions.

## Question 11(a)

### Candidate 24

The candidate was awarded **3 marks**.

The candidate was awarded mark 1 because the correct monthly effective rate of interest is implied by the multiplier. See Note 2 of the marking instructions

The candidate was awarded mark 2 because the balance has been calculated to include the monthly interest.

The candidate was awarded mark 3 because the minimum payment has been correctly calculated and deducted.

See COR Candidate B.

## Candidate 25

The candidate was awarded **1 mark**.

The candidate was not awarded mark 1 because they used the annual rate.

The candidate was awarded mark 2 as a follow through mark.

The candidate was not awarded mark 3 because the minimum payment has not been interpreted.

## Candidate 26

The candidate was awarded **2 marks**.

The candidate was awarded mark 1 because the correct monthly effective rate of interest is implied by the multiplier. See Note 2 of the marking instructions.

The candidate was awarded mark 2 because the balance has been calculated to include the monthly interest.

The candidate was not awarded mark 3 because the interest does not accumulate on the minimum payment.

## Question 11(b)

### Candidate 27

The candidate was awarded **0 marks**.

The candidate was not awarded mark 4 because the statement made is invalid.

## Candidate 28

The candidate was awarded **1 mark**.

The candidate was awarded mark 4 because they provided an appropriate statement.
