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3b	Using the same stage of transition - minimisation can be used to understand an individual's behaviour as they may try to continue with life as the transition has not happened and may appear happy and content, however they are just in the minimising stage of transition.
4	<p>Common sense knowledge is usually based on personal experience and include stereotypical beliefs. They also lack evidence/research to back up these claims.</p> <p>Sociological approach is based on evidence usually gained from systematic research used to then provide reliability + truth to claims made</p>
5	It is important to understand the concept of culture when working with individuals using care service as it allows the worker to approach service users with dignity/respect

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5	<p>when providing care - for example if you providing personal care to someone with a certain religion. It also ensures you do not indirectly discriminate due to lack of knowledge. This allows for service users to feel respected + dignified when receiving care.</p>	
6.	<p>One key feature of the functionalist theory is dysfunctionality. Dysfunctionality is when groups/individuals do not conform to norms, values + beliefs of wider society - therefore threatening society's stability.</p>	
7.	<p>Government influences the life chances of individuals using care services as they provide legislations to safe guard individuals - such as the equality act 2010 which protects those with disabilities/ mental illnesses from discrimination.* The government also provides free drug/alcohol rehabs + services.</p>	

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7.	<p>to individuals with substance misuse issues. This positively influences life chances as it encourages recovery in an easy to access way.</p> <p>* This positively influences life chances as it prevents discrimination which can further impact mental wellbeing.</p>
8a	<p>One health + social care principle is to be included. This ensures individuals are included in all aspects of decisions regarding their care and also any changes to their care.</p> <p>A second principle is compassion. This ensures individuals receive care that can show understanding and express empathy when supporting them.</p>
8b	<p>Be included underpins positive care practice as it provides person-centered care - which ensures the individual is in the centre of all aspects of their care.</p>

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9	<p>Assessment of needs involves finding the needs of the individual + how these can be met. Goals (SMART) are often set in this part of the planning process also. This is an important aspect of care planning as it sets a baseline of what needs to be met when care is implemented and how this is going to be done.</p>
10	<p>Equality Act 2010 promotes positive care practice as it promotes anti-discriminatory practice in the workplace and provides legal framework for working with individuals with the 9 protected characteristics - meaning workers are held accountable for their actions.</p>
	<p>Mental Health (Care + treatment) (Scotland) Act 2003 promotes positive care practice as it allows individuals to be involved in person centred planning through named</p>
