This answer falls short of the standard required at Higher level in terms of range, accuracy and lack of paragraphing.

Mark awarded: 6

The task is achieved but support for points is not always clear or developed. Coherence is weak in places and the message is difficult to follow at times. Style is appropriate, but there is no evidence of paragraphing, which is essential at Higher standard.

Range of vocabulary is limited, but mostly accurate although there are occasional spelling errors (*finantial*, *spirital*).

Only a limited range of structures is used with a high density of error (inclusion of articles: *a trouble. the heaven*) and repetitive use of structure (conditionals/ present tense).

The simplicity of the language used and lack of layout/paragraphing is reflected in the mark awarded.
