Candidate 7

The candidate achieves the task with support for each point made. The message is clear and well organised. Range and inaccuracies in grammar and punctuation limits the mark.

Mark awarded: 9

The task is fully achieved with clear support for points made. Writing is coherent and cohesive and conveys message with ease. Style and layout are wholly appropriate for the intended reader. Paragraph titles are used appropriately and effectively and support rather than dominate the task. Paragraphing follows conventions.

A wide range of vocabulary (*sluggish*, *energised*, *detrimental*) is generally, rather than always used accurately and effectively (*laid out* instead of *laid back*). Spelling is mainly accurate.

A wide range of structures is used with a reasonable level of accuracy. (*leading to a poor work*, *employees will get as much work done so that they get to*) A wider and more accurate range would be needed to increase the overall mark. Punctuation is sufficiently accurate.
