

Higher ESOL Writing – Everyday Life

The task is achieved and the candidate was awarded 7 marks, coherence is lacking at times and there are many spelling and grammar errors.

Content and organisation

There is some support for the points made. However, coherence is lacking at times (paragraph 4, That phones). Style and layout are appropriate.

Vocabulary and spelling

There are persistent spelling mistakes (straggle/struggle/babysite/tacks/tasks/reching/untill/wastet/wasted). Other vocabulary is relatively limited with the exception of items lifted from the rubric.

Grammar and punctuation

There are many basic grammar errors. However, there are some sophisticated sentences used accurately (This includes setting boundaries so if your friends .../If the time spent on your phone is ...) Punctuation is missing at times for example, a missing question mark in the first line and frequent missing commas.
