The Candidate was awarded 9 marks because while there are some good phrases, there are too many errors in the choice of words and phrases and grammar – making the piece quite challenging to read and mark.

Content and organisation

The task is fully achieved with clear support for points made. The writing is coherent and cohesive. Style is inconsistent, moving between a blog and an essay. Paragraphing follows conventions.

Vocabulary and spelling

A wide range of vocabulary is used (virtual world/overwhelming/realistic goals), but there are noticeable inappropriacy's (put the study behind your back/gears in the healthy lifestyle train/the throne of success) and spelling is mainly accurate with occasional errors (cassifying/assit/assist).

Grammar and punctuation

A wide range of grammatical structures is used effectively, but there is little complexity. Errors are more than occasional for example, (And here raise a question)
