The Candidate was awarded 8 marks, frequent grammar errors detract from a fully achieved task with clear support for points made.

Content and organisation

The task is fully achieved with clear support made for each point made. Writing is coherent and cohesive and conveys message with ease. The style and layout are wholly effective.

Vocabulary and spelling

A wide range of vocabulary is used accurately and effectively (capacity/revenue/expansion/shuttle bus/green area), but there are several spelling errors (loosing money/hight/dismanting).

Grammar and punctuation

A wide range of grammatical structures is used, and the message is conveyed with ease despite frequent errors for example, articles (It will result of loosing .../I would suggest to plan ahead .../there are limit number of public transport). Punctuation is consistent and appropriate.
