

Commentary on candidate evidence

The candidate evidence has achieved the following marks for each question of this component.

Candidate 1

Writing: Everyday Life

Identifier: Time for a plan

The candidate was awarded **8 marks** because despite the writing being coherent and cohesive, the density of grammar errors limits a higher mark being awarded.

Writing achieves the task with clear support for most points made. Writing is generally coherent and cohesive and the message is clear. Style and layout are appropriate and paragraphing follows conventions. (10-9)

A wide range of vocabulary is used 'overlooked/constant rush/have time for ourselves thanks to/physically/crucial/super tidy'. Spelling is generally accurate apart from slips with buing (buying) and distrected (distracted). (10-9)

Although there are some accurate grammatical structures 'be as organised as I could possibly be/not only able to do all task from my daily list, but also', the weakest aspect of this response is the grammar 'we tend to often overlooked, forget how important is to actually have time ... '/planned my daily task/when it comes to pre-organized my daily schedule/I've spend/I must to confess/I had really great time'. (8/7)
