

Commentary on candidate evidence

The candidate evidence has achieved the following marks for each question of this component.

Candidate 4

Writing: Everyday Life

Identifier: Imagine you finally put your mind in peace...

The candidate was awarded **5 marks** as the cohesion, vocabulary choices, grammar and punctuation are poor despite an interesting range of vocabulary.

The writing is loosely relevant to the task. There is a lack of coherence and cohesion, and the message is not always conveyed on first reading. (When reading the part about grouping tasks it is not clear if the candidate has understood). The structure is confused and the layout is poor with writing veering to the right.

There is some good vocabulary 'better version of myself', 'time waster', 'distracte', but frequent errors in the choice and use of vocabulary impede intelligibility 'Cleaning after myself', 'cleared my help', 'for keeping yourself distracted' is very confusing for the reader where logically undistracted would work better.

There are frequent grammatical errors – 'put your mind in peace/in task/one of this being investing/something you don't please/grouping tasking'. The profound lack of punctuation impedes communication.
