

Commentary on candidate evidence

The candidate evidence has achieved the following marks for each question of this component.

Candidate 5

Writing: Everyday Life

Identifier: People always talk about managing your time wisely.

The candidate was awarded **14 marks** as the piece of writing is generally optimal except in terms of not being enough like a blog.

The writing fully achieves the task, using language flexibly and effectively with well developed support for each point made. Writing is coherent and cohesive with a very positive impact on the reader. Style, however, is insufficiently like a blog: it reads at times more like an essay 'Furthermore...Conclusion'. Structure and paragraphing is consistent and coherent.

There is an optimum range of vocabulary used correctly 'delves/well-organised schedule/in terms of/spell disaster/naturally/categorising/slowly but surely/scorning/detrimental' and spelling is accurate apart from the slip with 'maintaing' (maintaining).

There is an optimum range of grammar, for example, accurately used variety of tenses - future continuous, future simple, past simple 'where you want to be' and a variety of accurate gerunds/superlative/ such a. Punctuation is accurate.
