

# Commentary on candidate 1 evidence

The evidence for this candidate has achieved the following marks for each section of this course assessment component:

## Section 1: planning

### 1a

The candidate gained **2 marks out of a possible 2 marks**.

The candidate correctly identified the first key theme (embellished) and provided a correct explanation, therefore 1 mark is awarded. The candidate correctly identified the second key theme (upcycled components) and provided a correct explanation, therefore 1 mark is awarded.

### 1b

The candidate gained **13 marks out of a possible 18 marks**.

Investigation 1 - The candidate gained **4 mark from a possible 6 marks**.

The candidate provided a valid research technique with sources; internet (1 mark), did not provide a justification for the investigation (0 marks) and provided three correct summary points linked to clothing, animals and fabric (3 marks). The candidate also provided additional summary points however marks were not awarded as the points were not accurate from the evidence within the investigations. Therefore, the candidate is awarded 4 marks for investigation 1.

Investigation 2 - The candidate gained **5 marks from a possible 6 marks**.

The candidate provided a valid and different research technique with sources; survey to parents (1 mark), did not provide a justification for the investigation (0 marks) and provided four correct summary points linked to dress, fastenings, colour and rabbits (4 marks). Therefore, the candidate is awarded 5 marks for investigation 2. The candidate also provided additional summary points linked to pattern, embellishments and pinafore which is noted but does not gain additional marks as the candidate has already achieve 4 marks in this area.

Investigation 3 - The candidate gained **4 marks from a possible 6 marks**.

The candidate provided a valid and different research technique with a source, interview (1 mark), did not provide a justification for the investigation (0 marks) and provided three correct summary points linked to cotton, embellishments and flowers (3 marks). The candidate also provided additional summary points linked to upcycled components and patch pockets however these point were taken from invalid evidence from the investigation or were from opinion therefore no additional marks were awarded, therefore the candidate is awarded 4 marks for investigation 3.

**1c**

The candidate gained **11 marks out of a possible 18 marks**.

The candidate provided an illustration with almost all details, therefore the candidate is awarded 4 marks.

**Bullet point 1**

Within design features, the candidate has provided information on an applique rabbit which links to investigations 1, 2 and 3 however this is a statement and a direct lift from the investigation and no justification provided therefore 0 marks is awarded.

**Bullet point 2**

Within design features, the candidate has provided information on a heart pocket which links to investigations 2 and 3 and has provided a justification therefore 1 mark is awarded.

**Bullet point 3**

Within design features, the candidate has provided information on flower embellishments which links to investigation 2 and 3 and has provided a justification therefore 1 mark is awarded.

**Bullet point 4**

Within design features, the candidate has provided information on a colour which links to investigation 2 however this is a statement and a direct lift from the investigation and no justification provided therefore 0 marks is awarded.

**Bullet point 5**

Within design features, the candidate has provided information on pattern which links to investigation 2 however this is a statement and no justification therefore 0 marks is awarded.

**Bullet point 6**

Within properties/characteristics, the candidate has provided information on cotton - absorbency which links to investigation 3 and has provided a justification therefore 1 mark is awarded.

**Bullet point 7**

Within properties/characteristics, the candidate has provided information on machine washable which links to investigation 2 and 3 and has provided a justification therefore 1 mark is awarded.

**Bullet point 8**

Within properties/characteristics, the candidate has provided information on durability which links to investigation 2 and 3 and has provided a justification therefore 1 mark is awarded.

**Bullet point 9**

Within properties/characteristics, the candidate has provided information on non-stretch which links to investigation 3, however this is a statement and no justification therefore 0 marks awarded.

**Bullet point 10**

Within construction techniques, the candidate has provided information on bound hem linked to investigation 3, however this is a statement not a justification therefore 0 marks is awarded.

**Bullet point 11**

Within construction techniques, the candidate has provided information on French seams linked to investigation 3 and has provided a justification therefore 1 mark is awarded.

**Bullet point 12**

Within construction techniques, the candidate has provided information on a buttonhole linked to investigation 2 and 3 and has provided a justification therefore 1 mark is awarded.

**Bullet point 13**

Within construction techniques, the candidate has provided information on top stitching linked to investigation 3 however there is a statement with no justification therefore 0 marks is awarded.

**Bullet point 14**

Within construction techniques, the candidate has provided information on top stitching linked to investigation 3 however there is a statement with no justification therefore 0 marks is awarded.

**Bullet point 15**

Within construction techniques, the candidate has provided information on gathering linked to investigation 3 however there is a statement with no justification, also there is minimal evidence therefore 0 marks is awarded.

**1d**

The candidate gained **2 marks out of a possible 4 marks**.

The candidate has provided a plan of work however there are a few inaccurate timing and there is a lack of detail in some of the steps therefore 2 marks is awarded.

**1e**

The candidate gained **3 marks out of a possible 4 marks**.

The candidate has provided a requisition detailing almost all the textiles and components. The candidate has provided detailed justifications for the textiles and components identified; therefore 3 marks is awarded.

## Section 3 - Evaluation

### 3a

The candidate gained **6 marks out of a possible 6 marks**.

The candidate has provided two different tests.

Test 1 - The candidate gained **3 marks from a possible 3 marks**.

The candidate provided a valid technique (sensory test) and identified an appropriate source (parents) therefore 1 mark is awarded. The candidate has presented their findings in a clear and logical manner therefore 2 marks are awarded. Therefore, the candidate is awarded 3 marks for test 1.

Test 2 - The candidate gained **3 marks from a possible 3 marks**.

The candidate provided a valid technique (interview) and identified an appropriate source (FTT teacher) therefore 1 mark is awarded. The candidate has presented their findings in a clear and logical manner therefore 2 marks are awarded. Therefore, the candidate is awarded 3 marks for test 2.

### 3b

The candidate gained **3 marks out of a possible 6 marks**.

Evaluation 1 - The candidate has correctly identified upcycled fabric as a link to their item, has linked the fact to evidence (test 1 and 2), has made a judgement, and an impact against the fact therefore 1 mark is awarded.

Evaluation 2 - The candidate has correctly identified the embellishments as a link to their item, has linked the fact to evidence (test 1) and has made a judgement, however the candidates impact is a repeat of their opinion and does not provide a full consequence therefore 0 marks is awarded.

Evaluation 3 - The candidate has correctly identified quality as a link to their item, has linked the fact to evidence (test 1 and 2), has made a judgement, and an impact against the fact therefore 1 mark is awarded.

Evaluation 4 - The candidate has correctly identified the pinafore as a link to their item, has linked the fact to evidence (test 1) and has made a judgement, however the impact provided is a repeat of the opinion therefore 0 marks is awarded.

Evaluation 5 - The candidate has correctly identified cotton as a link to their item, has linked the fact to evidence (test 1), has made a judgement, however the fact is not valid as it links to durability and comfort (soft) which would require a wearer trial rather than a sensory test therefore 0 marks is awarded.

Evaluation 6 - The candidate has correctly identified the colour as a link to their item, has linked the fact to evidence (test 1), has made a judgement, and an impact against the fact therefore 1 mark is awarded.

**3c**

The candidate gained **2 marks out of a possible 2 marks.**

The candidate has provided an adaption (embroidered colour on the rabbit embellishment) and has linked it to tests 1 and 2 therefore 1 mark is awarded. The candidate has provided an adaption (button to snap fastenings) and has linked it to tests 1 and 2 therefore 1 mark is awarded.

**The candidate was awarded 42 marks out of a total of 60 marks available for the assignment.**

# Commentary on candidate 2 evidence

The evidence for this candidate has achieved the following marks for each section of this course assessment component:

## Section 1: planning

### 1a

The candidate gained **2 marks out of a possible 2 marks**.

The candidate has correctly identified the first key theme (teenagers) and provided a correct explanation, therefore 1 mark is awarded. The candidate has correctly identified the second key theme (celebrity endorsed range) and provided a correct explanation, therefore 1 mark is awarded.

### 1b

The candidate gained **6 marks out of a possible 18 marks**.

Investigation 1 - The candidate gained **1 mark from a possible 6 marks**.

The candidate provided a valid research technique; internet (1 mark), did not provide a justification for the investigation (0 marks) and provided four summary points linked to cotton, colour, fit and zips however these points were either statements or did not reflect evidence from the investigations therefore 0 marks is awarded. Therefore, the candidate is awarded 1 mark for investigation 1.

Investigation 2 - The candidate gained **5 marks from a possible 6 marks**.

The candidate provided a valid and different research technique; survey to teenagers (1 mark), did not provide a justification for the investigation (0 marks) and provided four summary points linked to A-line shape, colour, sleeves, length and pockets (4 marks). Therefore, the candidate is awarded 5 marks for investigation 2. The candidate also provided an additional summary point linked to round neck which is noted but does not gain additional marks as the candidate has already achieved 4 marks in this area.

Investigation 3 - The candidate gained **0 marks from a possible 6 marks**.

The candidate provided a valid and different research technique, interview, however did not provide information of the source (0 marks), did not provide a justification for the investigation (0 marks) and provided four summary points linked to fabric, fastenings, the sleeve and colour however these points were either statements or did not reflect evidence from the investigations (0 marks), therefore the candidate is awarded 0 marks for investigation 3.

**1c**

The candidate gained **7 marks out of a possible 18 marks**.

The candidate provided an illustration with an adequate amount of detail; therefore, the candidate is awarded 2 marks.

**Bullet point 1**

Within design features, the candidate has provided information on a zip which links to investigations 1 and 3 however there is a statement and no justification therefore 0 marks is awarded.

**Bullet point 2**

Within design features, the candidate has provided information on a hook and eye which links to investigations 2 and 3 and has provided a justification therefore 1 mark is awarded.

**Bullet point 3**

Within design features, the candidate has provided information on long sleeves which links to investigation 2 however there is a statement and no justification therefore 0 marks is awarded.

**Bullet point 4**

Within design features, the candidate has provided information on a pocket which links to investigation 2 and has provided a justification therefore 1 mark is awarded.

**Bullet point 5**

Within design features, the candidate has provided information on an A-line shape which links to investigation 2 however this is a statement and no justification therefore 0 marks is awarded.

**Bullet point 6**

Within design features, the candidate has provided information on a round neck which links to investigation 2 and has provided a justification therefore 1 mark is awarded.

**Bullet point 7**

Within properties/characteristics, the candidate has provided information on drape which links to investigation 3 and has provided a justification therefore 1 mark is awarded.

**Bullet point 8**

Within properties/characteristics, the candidate has provided information on cotton however this is not a property or characteristic therefore 0 marks is awarded.

**Bullet point 9**

Within properties/characteristics, the candidate has provided information on elasticity however there is no link to evidence from the investigations therefore 0 marks is awarded.

**Bullet point 10**

Within properties/characteristics, the candidate has provided information on strength however there is no link to evidence from the investigations therefore 0 marks is awarded.

**Bullet point 11**

Within construction techniques, the candidate has provided information on darts linked to investigation 1, however this is not accurate and the evidence in this investigation shows a fitted item made from Lycra rather than darts therefore 0 marks is awarded.

**Bullet point 12**

Within construction techniques, the candidate has provided information on top stitching linked to investigation 3 and has provided a justification therefore 1 mark is awarded.

**Bullet point 13**

Within construction techniques, the candidate has provided information on a lining linked to investigation 2 however the justification is opinion and not based on evidence from the investigations therefore 0 marks is awarded.

**Bullet point 14**

Within construction techniques, the candidate has provided information on seams linked to investigation 3 however this is a statement and no justification therefore 0 marks is awarded.

**1d**

The candidate gained **1 mark out of a possible 4 marks.**

The candidate has provided a plan of work, however it has been written retrospectively, there are a number of inaccurate timings, times are not broken down and there is a lack of detail therefore 1 mark is awarded.

**1e**

The candidate gained **1 mark out of a possible 4 marks.**

The candidate has provided a requisition detailing some of the textiles and components however the candidate has given measurements in imperial rather than metric, the detail of the type of zip is missing and the size of the hook and eye. The candidate has provided basic justifications for the textiles and components therefore 1 mark is awarded.



## Section 3 - Evaluation

### 3a

The candidate gained **6 marks out of a possible 6 marks**.

The candidate has provided two different tests.

Test 1 - The candidate gained **3 marks from a possible 3 marks**.

The candidate provided a valid technique (survey) and identified an appropriate source (teenagers) (1 mark). The candidate has presented their findings in a clear and logical manner (2 marks). Therefore, the candidate is awarded 3 marks for test 1.

Test 2 - The candidate gained **3 marks from a possible 3 marks**.

The candidate provided a valid technique (interview) and identified an appropriate source (Fashion and Textile Technology teacher) (1 mark). The candidate has presented their findings in a clear and logical manner (2 marks). Therefore, the candidate is awarded 3 marks for test 1.

### 3b

The candidate gained **4 marks out of a possible 6 marks**.

Evaluation 1: The candidate has correctly identified fabric as a link to their item, has linked the fact to evidence (test 2), has made a judgement, and an impact against the fact therefore 1 mark is awarded.

Evaluation 2: The candidate has correctly identified the zip as a link to their item, has linked the fact to evidence (test 1), has made a judgement, and an impact against the fact therefore 1 mark is awarded.

Evaluation 3: The candidate has correctly identified A-line as a link to their item, has linked the fact to evidence (test 1), has made a judgement, however has not provided a different impact against the fact (repeat of point 2) therefore 0 marks is awarded.

Evaluation 4: The candidate has correctly identified the neckline as a link to their item, has linked the fact to evidence (test 1), has made a judgement, and an impact against the fact therefore 1 mark is awarded.

Evaluation 5: The candidate has correctly identified the pockets as a link to their item, has linked the fact to evidence (test 1), has made a judgement, however have not provided an impact against the fact therefore 0 marks is awarded.

Evaluation 6: The candidate has correctly identified the sleeves as a link to their item, has linked the fact to evidence (test 1), has made a judgement, and an impact against the fact therefore 1 mark is awarded.

**3c**

The candidate gained **0 marks out of a possible 2 marks**.

The candidate has provided an adaption (exposed pockets) however there is no evidence from the tests or investigations therefore 0 marks is awarded. The candidate has provided an adaption (embroidery) however there is no evidence from the tests or investigations therefore 0 marks is awarded.

**The candidate was awarded 27 marks out of a total of 60 marks available for the assignment.**
