

# Commentary on candidate 1 evidence

The evidence for this candidate has achieved the following marks for each question of this course assessment component:

## Question 1(a)

The candidate was awarded **9 marks out of the 10 marks available** because:

The candidate has correctly identified three key features; colour, shape and texture. The candidate has provided examples linked to each of the three key features from the images; therefore 3 marks are awarded.

### Key feature one – colour

The candidate has given a correct discussion point for the ombre sunset and has applied it to a garment (swimsuit); therefore, 1 mark is awarded.

The candidate has given a correct discussion point for the pink and green flowers and has applied it to a garment (colour block summer top); therefore, 1 mark is awarded.

The candidate has given a correct discussion point for the black silhouettes of the palm trees and has applied it to a garment (black swimsuit); therefore, 1 mark is awarded.

The candidate has given a correct discussion point for the pink sky and has applied it to a garment (pink shorts), however this is a repeat of the third point (black swimsuit) therefore no mark is awarded. If the candidate had linked the colour pink to an embellishment/design feature/fabric pattern and not just the colour of the item they could have gained a mark.

The candidate has given a correct discussion point for the yellow/orange reflection on the water and has applied it to a garment (yellow & orange stripe t-shirt), therefore 1 mark is awarded.

### Key feature two – shape

The candidate has given a correct discussion point for the semi-circle shape of the sun and has applied it to a garment (half circle skirt), therefore 1 mark is awarded.

The candidate has given a discussion point for the triangle shape from the flower and has applied it to a garment (bell sleeves on a top), however the shape identified is incorrect and does not correctly represent the shape of the flower, therefore no mark is awarded.

The candidate has given a correct discussion point for the palm leaves and has applied it to a garment (layered skirt), however the candidate has not explained the shape in detail and it cannot be clearly visualised on the item, therefore no mark is awarded.

**Key feature three – texture**

The candidate has given a correct discussion point for the smooth water and has applied it to a garment (silky overcoat), therefore 1 mark is awarded.

# Commentary on candidate 2 evidence

The evidence for this candidate has achieved the following marks for each question of this course assessment component:

## Question 1(a)

The candidate was awarded **7 marks out of the 10 marks available** because:

The candidate has correctly identified two key features; colour and shape. The candidate has provided examples linked to each of the two key features from the images; therefore 2 marks are awarded.

### Key feature one – colour

The candidate has given a correct discussion point for the purple sky and has applied it to a garment (dress); therefore, 1 mark is awarded.

The candidate has given a correct discussion point for the green stem of the flower and has applied it to a garment (skirt); however, this is a repeat of the first point (purple dress) therefore no mark is awarded. If the candidate had linked the colour green to an embellishment/design feature/fabric pattern and not just the colour of the item they could have gained a mark.

The candidate has given a correct discussion point for the yellow sun and red sky and has applied it to a garment (red shorts with yellow embroidery), therefore 1 mark is awarded.

### Key feature two – shape

The candidate has given a correct discussion point for the reflection of the sun on the water linked to stripes and has applied it to a garment (striped fabric t-shirt), therefore 1 mark is awarded.

The candidate has given a correct discussion point for the triangle shape from the boat sail and has applied it to a garment (V-neck t-shirt), therefore 1 mark is awarded.

The candidate has given a correct discussion point for the shape of the hill and has applied it to a garment (blouse with balloon sleeves), therefore 1 mark is awarded.

# Commentary on candidate 3 evidence

The evidence for this candidate has achieved the following marks for each question of this course assessment component:

## Question 1(a)

The candidate was awarded **6 marks out of the 10 marks available** because:

The candidate has correctly identified two key features; colour and shape. The candidate has provided examples linked to each of the two key features from the images; therefore 2 marks are awarded.

### Key feature one – colour

The candidate has given a correct discussion point for the yellow sun and has applied it to a garment (yellow t-shirt); therefore, 1 mark is awarded.

The candidate has given a correct discussion point for the yellow of the sun and has applied it to a garment (yellow shorts); however, this is a repeat of the first point (yellow t-shirt) therefore no mark is awarded. If the candidate had linked the colour yellow to an embellishment/design feature/fabric pattern and not just the colour to the item they could have gained a mark.

The candidate has given a correct discussion point for the green leaves and has applied it to a garment (green swimsuit and cigarette trousers); however, this is a repeat of the first and second points therefore no mark is awarded. If the candidate had linked the colour green to an embellishment/design feature/fabric pattern and not just the colour to the item they could have gained a mark.

The candidate has given a correct discussion point for the purple sunset and has applied it to a garment (purple skirt, shorts and sandals); however, this is a repeat of the above points therefore no marks were awarded. If the candidate had linked the colour purple to an embellishment/design feature/fabric pattern and not just the colour to the item they could have gained a mark.

### Key feature two – shape

The candidate has given a correct discussion point for the triangular shape of the boat and has applied it to a garment (triangle bikini), therefore 1 mark is awarded.

The candidate has given a correct discussion point for the triangle shape of the boat and has applied it to a garment (V-neck t-shirt), therefore 1 mark is awarded.

The candidate has given a correct discussion point for the triangle shape of the boat and has applied it to a garment (flared trousers), therefore 1 mark is awarded.

The candidate has given a discussion point for the shape of the flower and has applied it to a garment (t-shirt with floral pattern), however the candidate has not explained the shape of the flower in detail and also has not described how the pattern will be applied to the t-shirt ie, embroidery/applique/beads/fabric pattern, therefore no mark is awarded.

# Commentary on candidate 4 evidence

The evidence for this candidate has achieved the following marks for each question of this course assessment component:

## Question 1(a)

The candidate was awarded **5 marks out of the 10 marks available** because:

The candidate has correctly identified two key features; colour and texture. The candidate has provided examples linked to each of the two key features from the images; therefore 2 marks are awarded.

### **(Bullet point 1: linked to key feature – colour)**

The candidate has given a correct discussion point for the vibrant sunset and has applied it to a garment (pink/purple top); therefore, 1 mark is awarded.

### **(Bullet point 2: linked to key feature – texture)**

The candidate has given a correct discussion point for the smooth sky and has applied it to a garment (silky top), therefore 1 mark is awarded.

### **(Bullet point 3: is not correctly linked to a key feature)**

The candidate has given embellishments as a key feature which is not correct and the discussion point is vague and cannot be easily visualised therefore no mark is awarded.

### **(Bullet point 4: linked to key feature – colour)**

The candidate has given a discussion point for the blue sea and has applied it to a garment (skirt); however, this is incorrect as there is no blue in any of the images therefore no mark is awarded. If the candidate had provided the correct colour a mark would have been awarded.

### **(Bullet point 5: is not correctly linked to a key feature)**

The candidate has given style as a key feature which is not correct therefore no mark is awarded.

### **(Bullet point 6: is not correctly linked to a key feature)**

The candidate has given fabric as a key feature which is not correct and has not correctly linked the discussion point to examples from the images, therefore no mark is awarded.

### **(Bullet point 7: linked to key feature – colour)**

The candidate has given a correct discussion point for the colour of the flower and the stem and has applied it to a garment (pink or green shorts), therefore 1 mark is awarded.

### **(Bullet point 8: is not correctly linked to a key feature)**

The candidate has given style as a key feature which is not correct therefore no mark is awarded.

**(Bullet point 9: is not correctly linked to a key feature)**

The candidate has given embellishments as a key feature which is not correct and has not linked the discussion point to examples from the images, therefore no mark is awarded.
