Choose **one** of the following two scenarios.

SCENARIO 1 — Learning

Last summer you took part in an exchange with an Italian school/college. You travelled with a group of students and teachers and stayed with your Italian exchange partner.
On your return from the visit you have been asked to write a report in Italian for the foreign language section of your school website

You must include the following information and **you should try to add** other relevant details:

- What part of Italy you went to **and** for how long
- What you liked/disliked about the Italian school/college
- How you got on with your exchange partner
- If you intend to keep in touch with your partner in the future

You should write approximately 120–150 words.

OR

SCENARIO 2 — Culture

During the summer holidays you visited an Italian friend and stayed with his/her family for two weeks. You have been asked to write a report in **Italian** on your visit for your school/college magazine.

You must include the following information and **you should try to add** other relevant details:

- Where exactly you went **and** who met you on arrival
- How you got on with the Italian family
- What you enjoyed/did not enjoy about the Italian lifestyle
- What you intend to do when your Italian friend visits Scotland next year.

You should write approximately 120–150 words.
