The evidence for this candidate has achieved the following marks for the following sections of this course assessment component.

D. Drawing a detailed and reasoned conclusion(s) about the issue

The candidate attempts to provide a conclusion on the differences and similarities between conservative and liberal ideology.

The candidate makes a detailed conclusion regarding the differences between liberalism and conservatism. This detail extends to two aspects, human nature and equality, and the conclusion is enhanced with an additional contrast with socialism.

This candidate attempts to draw a conclusion around the similarities of the two ideologies but it is quite weak and vague.

As a result, the candidate was credited for one conclusion made with detailed reference to the evidence. The final part of this conclusion did not satisfy the criteria which would have enabled further marks to be awarded.

The candidate was awarded **2 out of 4 marks** for conclusions.
