

**Candidate 1- Everyday Life**

The evidence and commentary for this candidate were used within the ESOL National 5 and Higher Writing webinar in January 2024.

**This is a very strong example of everyday life at this level, in terms of support for points made and accurate use of a variety of vocabulary and grammatical structures.**

**Mark awarded: 14**

**Content and organisation**

The task is fully achieved with well-developed support for each point made. Writing is coherent and cohesive with a very positive impact on the reader. On the first read through it is clear this is a comprehensive and detailed answer. Style and layout are wholly appropriate for the intended reader. The candidate has understood their role and that of the reader. There is clear evidence of structure/paragraphing.

**Vocabulary and spelling**

The candidate uses an optimum range of vocabulary accurately and appropriately within the context of the task, individual items and phrases: 'relief', 'based on', 'handouts', 'diverse', 'discoloured', 'just the right selection', 'at very decent prices'.

There are minor spelling errors which do not affect comprehension.

**Grammar and punctuation**

The candidate uses an optimum range of grammatical structures appropriately with a high level of accuracy: 'I found that they were...', 'Something that impressed me was...', 'I would say the cleanliness could be improved'.

Punctuation is accurate.
