Environmental issues

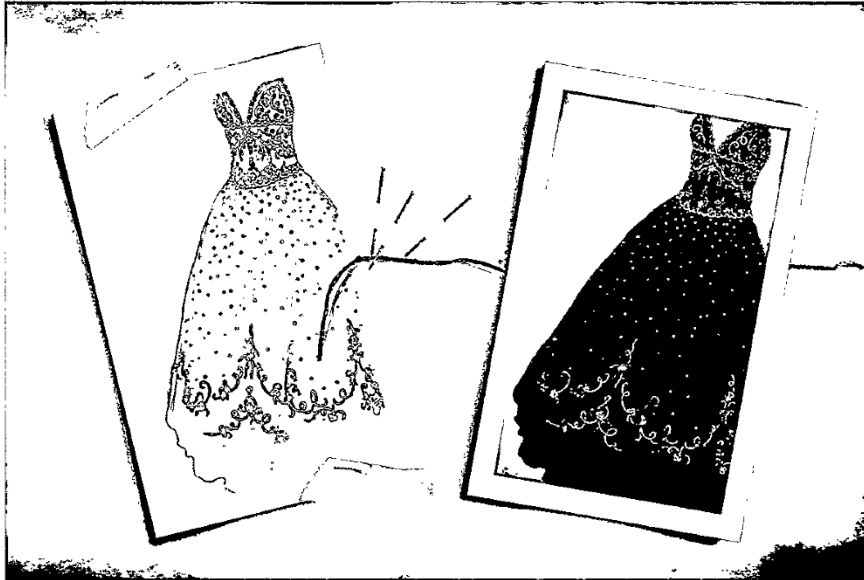
Explanation 1 Weather may be bad/cold meaning that they will look for party wear that is more capable of keeping them warm due to their climate.

Explanation 2 Method of making clothing that particularly damages the environment or hurt them further might change their perspective on these methods and not want to buy.

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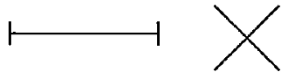
Question 3

A Fashion and Textile pupil is using a commercial paper pattern to make a Prom dress.

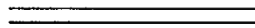


- (a) Identify each of the following pattern markings that would be found on the commercial paper pattern for the Prom dress.

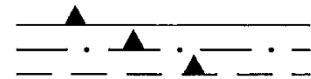
