

Candidate B

The evidence for this candidate has achieved the following marks for each question of this course assessment component:

1(a)

The candidate was awarded **0 marks out of the 3 marks available** because:

The candidate has given an incorrect response; therefore, no mark is awarded. The candidate has given two reasons for the suitability of cotton. Cotton is not a synthetic fibre; therefore no marks are awarded.

1(b)

The candidate was awarded **0 marks out of the 3 marks available** because:

Evaluation 1: The candidate has correctly identified warmth as a feature of knitted fabrics, and has made a judgement, but has not made a link to the requirements of the hooded top to be worn at a sports event, therefore no mark is awarded.

Evaluation 2: The candidate has correctly identified absorbent as a feature of knitted fabrics but has not made a judgement or linked this to the requirements of the top, therefore no mark is awarded.

Evaluation 3: The candidate has stated that knitted fabrics are easy to wash and will keep its shape. Neither of these are features of knitted fabric, therefore no mark is awarded.

1(c)

The candidate was awarded **0 marks out of the 3 marks available** because:

Advantage 1: The candidate has made a statement relating to time but has not described an advantage of this to the consumer, therefore no mark is awarded.

Advantage 2: The candidate has made a statement relating to ease of purchase but has not described an advantage of this to the consumer, therefore no mark is awarded.

Disadvantage 1: The candidate has made a statement relating to assessing the item from online information, but has not described why this is a disadvantage, therefore no mark is awarded.

Disadvantage 2: The candidate has made a statement relating to not being able to try the top on, but has not described why this is a disadvantage, therefore no mark is awarded.

For Question 1, the candidate was awarded a total of 0 marks out of a total 10 marks.

2(a)

The candidate was awarded **1 mark out of the 4 marks available** because:

Fabric Quantity chart

Reason 1+2: The candidate has given information about suggested fabrics which is not related to the fabric quantity chart, therefore no marks are awarded.

Back View:

Reason 1: The candidate has given a correct reason for the importance of the information (to show what the back of the dress will look like and how to make it), therefore a mark is awarded.

Reason 2: No response.

2(b)

The candidate was awarded **0 marks out of the 2 marks available** because:

Method 1+2: Both responses are incorrect, therefore no marks are awarded.

2(c)

The candidate was awarded **0 marks out of the 4 marks available** because:

Evaluation 1: The candidate has correctly identified durable as a property of cotton, but has not made a judgement, or made a link to the requirements of the party dress, therefore no mark is awarded.

Evaluation 2: The candidate has identified an incorrect property of cotton (warm), therefore no mark is awarded.

Evaluation 3: The candidate has correctly identified absorbency as a property of cotton, and has made a judgement (suitable), but has not made a link to the requirements of the party dress, therefore no mark is awarded.

Evaluation 4: The candidate has identified an incorrect property of cotton (hard to crease), therefore no mark is awarded.

For Question 2, the candidate was awarded a total of 1 mark out of a total 10 marks.

3(a)

The candidate was awarded **1 mark out of the 6 marks available** because:

Style:

Description 1: The candidate has not provided a description of a style feature; therefore, no mark is awarded.

Explanation 1: The candidate has made a statement about the perceived style of a celebrity. This is too vague and not based on any style feature, therefore no mark is awarded.

Description 2: The candidate has not provided a description of a style feature; therefore, no mark is awarded.

Explanation 2: The candidate has made a statement about the celebrity needing to feel comfortable. This is too vague and not based on a style feature, therefore no mark is awarded.

Embellishment:

Description: When taken along with the response for the explanation, the candidate has correctly identified sequins as an appropriate embellishment, therefore a mark is awarded.

Explanation: The candidate has not offered any further explanation; therefore no mark is awarded.

3(b)

The candidate was awarded **0 marks out of the 4 marks available** because:

Factor 1: The candidate has correctly identified an appropriate factor (suitable for all ages), but has not shown a connection between this and the context of the question, therefore no mark is awarded.

Factor 2: The candidate has correctly identified an appropriate factor (style), but has not shown a connection between this and the context of the question, therefore no mark is awarded.

Factor 3: The candidate has correctly identified two appropriate factors (comfort and durability), but has not shown a connection between either of these and the context of the question, therefore no mark is awarded.

Factor 4: The candidate has correctly identified an appropriate factor (price), but has not shown a connection between this and the context of the question, therefore no mark is awarded.

For Question 3, the candidate was awarded a total of **1 mark out of a total 10 marks**.
