The evidence for this candidate has achieved the following marks for each question of this course assessment component.

1a(ii)	<b>1 mark</b> was awarded for 'dowell joint' the candidate was not penalised for the incorrect spelling of dowel.	1	1
1a(iii)	<b>0 marks</b> were awarded as the candidate could not identify a bridle joint.	0	1
1b.	<b>2 marks</b> were awarded.  Stage 1- the candidate has shown the position of the shoulder.  Stage 2- 1 mark was awarded for depth with the marking gauge.  The candidate has used sketches to aid with the answers, this has added clarity to the candidate's description of the marking out of the corner halving joint.	2	3
1c.	<b>1 mark</b> was awarded for 'plough plane'.	1	1
1d.	<b>2 marks</b> were awarded for correctly identifying and completing the table with either hardwood or softwoods.	2	4
1e.	<b>1 mark</b> was awarded as both points relate to the same area, which in the marking instructions relate to deforestation.	1	2
1f.	<b>1 mark</b> was awarded for 'varnish'.	1	1
2a.	<b>4 marks</b> were awarded for correctly completing part of the cutting list.	4	6
2b(i)	<b>1 mark</b> was awarded for 'mortice machine'. The candidate was not penalised for the incorrect spelling of mortise.	1	1
2b(ii)	<b>0 marks</b> were awarded as the candidate did not identify a disc sander.	0	1

2c.	<b>0 marks</b> were awarded as the candidate did not correctly identify a rebate plane.	0	1
2d.	<b>0 marks</b> were awarded as the candidate did not correctly identify a band clamp.	0	1
2e.	<b>1 mark</b> was awarded for 'no gaps' and 'fits before gluing' as the candidate has inferred they are checking the assembly before gluing.	1	1
2f.	<b>1 mark</b> was awarded for 'PVA'.	1	1

2h.	<b>0 marks</b> were awarded as the candidate did not make reference to, 'to raise the grain'.	0	1

3e(i)	<b>0 marks</b> were awarded as candidate could not identify a sliding bevel.	0	1
3e(ii)	<b>1 mark</b> was awarded for referring to 'can be set/adjusted to draw lines at a range of angles to an edge'.	1	1
3e(iii)	<b>0 marks</b> were awarded as the candidate could not identify a marking knife.	0	1

3e(iv)	<b>0 marks</b> were awarded as the candidate could not describe the use of a marking knife.	0	1
3f.	<b>1 mark</b> was awarded for referring to 'keeps the saw blade rigid'.	1	1
4a.	<b>1 mark</b> was awarded for the candidate 'using a compass to mark out the circumference'. The sketch has aided the candidate's response by showing they are referring to marking a circle on the blank.	1	2
4b.	<b>0 marks</b> were awarded as the candidate could not identify the parts of the smoothing plane.	0	4
4c.	<b>0 marks</b> were awarded as the candidate could not identify a face plate.	0	1
4d.	<b>0 marks.</b> No response.	0	1
4e(i)	<b>0 marks</b> were awarded as the candidate could not identify a gouge.	0	1
4e(ii)	<b>1 mark</b> was awarded for 'scraper'.	1	1
4f.	<b>0 marks</b> were awarded as candidate could not correctly identify the correct height of the cutting tool. Box B.	0	1
4g.	<b>2 marks</b> were awarded for referring to the following points in the marking instructions – 1. 'wet the wood' 2. 'sand on machine'	2	3
4h.	<b>0 marks</b> were awarded as responses 1 and 2 refer to machine checks rather than personal safety checks and so no marks can be awarded.	0	3
