1b.	<b>1 mark</b> was awarded for combining stages 1 and 2 to give the candidate 1 mark. These two stages refer to 'marking size of shoulder' from the marking instructions  Stage 3 – there was no mention of tools and the sketch lacked enough detail to be awarded any marks.	1	3
1c.	<b>1 mark</b> was awarded for 'plough plane'.	1	1
1d.	<b>3 marks</b> were awarded for correctly identifying and completing the table with either hardwood or softwoods.	3	4
1e.	<b>1 mark</b> was awarded response 1 'softwoods grow faster' achieves the mark. Response 2 doesn't have enough information to achieve a mark.	1	2
1f.	<b>1 mark</b> was awarded for 'varnish'.	1	1
2a.	<b>4 marks</b> were awarded for correctly completing part of the cutting list.	4	6
2b(i)	<b>1 mark</b> was awarded for 'mortiscising machine'. The candidate has not been penalised for the incorrect spelling of mortise.	1	1
2b(ii)	<b>0 marks</b> were awarded as the candidate did not correctly identify a disc sander.	0	1

2e.	<b>1 mark</b> was awarded for 'all parts fit properly and see if any adjustments are required' this referring to 'check assembly before gluing'.	1	1

4a.	<b>1 mark</b> was awarded in stage 1 for referring to point in the marking instructions - 'marking circle/octagonal shape'.	1	2
