

Commentary on candidate evidence

The candidate evidence has achieved the following marks for each part of this assignment.

Candidate 6

The candidate was awarded **20 out of 20 marks**.

Standard A

The candidate was awarded **4 marks**. There is an opening section dealing with significance and impact in detail, but the whole report is about the impact of belief in God, therefore the candidate easily achieves full marks for this part.

Standards B, C and D

The candidate was awarded **10 marks**. The title does not really reflect the issue. The report is clearly exploring whether belief in God is what will give people meaning in life, and this is explored in detail, including alternative non-religious perspectives. There is some excellent analysis and explanation, and use of a wide range of sources including religious texts and thinkers.

Standards E and F

The candidate was awarded **6 marks**. The final conclusion is clear and detailed, and the candidate also offers concluding points on their question as they go, drawing on the evidence they have presented. Their view is clear, and fully justified, so this part also achieves full marks.
