Section 1 - Total marks 31/60

Q1(a) (i)

The candidate was awarded **1 mark** because 'Birch' is a correct response.

Q1(a) (ii)

The candidate was awarded **0 marks** because the response is incorrect.

Q1(a) (iii)

The candidate was awarded **1 mark** because 'Parallel turning.' is a correct response.

Q1(a) (iv)

The candidate was awarded **0 marks** because the response is incorrect.

Q1(b) (i)

The candidate was awarded **2 marks** because 'Plane' and 'Tenon saw' are correct responses.

Q1(b) (ii)

The candidate was awarded **0 marks** because the response is incorrect.

Q1(b) (iii)

The candidate was awarded **2 marks** because 'use a tri-square to see if all four angles are 90°' and 'measure diagonally from corner to corner.' are correct responses.

Q1(c) (i)

The candidate was awarded **2 marks** because 'comes in a big sheet' and 'environmentally friendly' (sufficient depth of knowledge at National 5) are correct responses.

Q1(c) (ii)

The candidate was awarded **2 marks** because 'drill bit is secured' and 'wood securely placed.' are correct responses.

Q1(c) (iii)

The candidate was awarded **3 marks** because 'could apply varnish to give it a better finish', 'two or more coats' and 'sand and use wet and dry paper' are correct responses. The responses from the candidate are not necessarily in the correct order, but this is a describe question so 3 marks can be awarded.

Q1(d)

The candidate was awarded **0 marks** because the response is incorrect.

Q1(e) (i)

The candidate was awarded **2 marks** because 'it doesn't rust' and 'strong' are correct responses.

Q1(e) (ii)

The candidate was awarded **1 mark** because 'use a scribe to mark' is a correct response.

Q1(e) (iii)

The candidate was awarded **1 mark** because 'tin snips to cut round the corner' is a correct response.

Q1(e) (iv)

The candidate was awarded **1 mark** because 'hit it until it sort of wraps around the corner of the anvil' is a correct response.

Q2(a) (i)

The candidate was awarded **0 marks** because the response is incorrect.

Q2(a) (ii)

The candidate was awarded **0 marks** because the response is incorrect.

Q2(b)

The candidate was awarded **1 mark** because 'know what the design must have.' is a correct response.

Q2(c)

The candidate was awarded **0 marks** because the response is incorrect.

Q3(a)

The candidate was awarded **1 mark** because 'To see what it would look like' is a correct response.

Q3(b)

The candidate was awarded **1 mark** because 'see how parts fit together' is a correct response.

Q4

The candidate was awarded **2 marks** because 'see if the design can be made' and 'look for things that could be changed.' are correct responses ('helps you think of different materials and sizes' is a continuation of the same point).

Q5(a)

The candidate was awarded **1 mark** because 'handle and how comfortable it is.' is a correct response. The other descriptions are too vague and do not attract any further marks.

Q5(b)

The candidate was awarded **1 mark** because 'The small iron holder on the side of the ironing board' is a correct response.

Q5(c)

The candidate was awarded **2 marks** because 'thermosetting plastic ... meaning the iron won't melt' and 'has a stand ... prevents burning' are correct responses.

Q6(a)

The candidate was awarded **1 mark** because 'colours are bright' is a correct response.

Q6(b)

The candidate was awarded **1 mark** because 'More people would be inclined to buy it' is a correct response. 'the brand also makes a lot of money' does not clearly refer to premium pricing so no further marks are awarded here.

Q6(c)

The candidate was awarded **2 marks** because 'Posters' and 'Celebrity endorsements.' are correct responses.

The candidate was awarded **2 marks** because 'iron' and 'its heavy' are correct responses.

Q7(a) (ii)

The candidate was awarded **1 mark** because 'it won't get weak over time' is a correct response.

Q7(b)

The candidate was awarded **1 mark** because 'looks rough.' is a correct response.

Q7(c)

The candidate was awarded **1 mark** because 'shiny mirror like finish.' is a correct response

Q7(d)

The candidate was awarded **2 marks** because 'Rotational moulding' and 'hollow meaning it could be filled with concrete.' are correct responses.

Q8(a)

The candidate was awarded **1 mark** because 'polution ... makes people unwell.' is a correct response. This is an example of a suitably linked environmental response.

Q8(b)

The candidate was awarded **0 marks** because the response is incorrect.

Q9

The candidate was awarded **1 mark** because 'come in bulk' is a correct response. 'They are inexpensive' is an unqualified quick.

Q10

The candidate was awarded **4 marks** because 'Stop using fossil fuels', 'use recyclable materials', 'for every sell they plant a tree' and 'use solar panels to power the work place.' are correct responses.
