National 5 ESOL writing – Every Day life

Candidate 1

The candidate achieved 7 marks because of a limited range of vocabulary and grammar (despite reasonably high accuracy), a lack of development of ideas and an inappropriate register for the task.

Mark warded: 7

The candidate has not managed to achieve an appropriate style for a formal email with frequent examples of informal register (for example, *Hello... This is... How has your day been?*)

The content is relevant to the task but there is no attempt to develop points, which are mostly presented as lists. Writing is coherent, and the message is clearly conveyed. In this aspect, the task may be achieved.

Only a limited range of vocabulary is used, but with a high level of accuracy (except for 'health box'). Spelling is mostly accurate.

Although there are few errors in grammatical structures (for example, *who may are not able to get*'), the range of structures, for a N5 candidate, is limited.

Punctuation is mostly used accurately and appropriately, but there is inappropriate use of exclamation marks.
