Candidate 2

This is a strong piece of writing which contains well-developed ideas that create a positive impact on the reader. There is a high level of accuracy in grammatical structures and punctuation, and a very wide range of vocabulary used.

Mark awarded: 13

This candidate fully achieves the task. Writing is coherent and cohesive and has a positive impact on the reader. The style and layout are appropriate for a formal email. There is a clear structure, with paragraphs used correctly to provide detailed and well-developed ideas.

The range of vocabulary is near optimum for the level, and it is used accurately (for example, *lighting, encourage, attract people, litter, get bullied, new opportunities, consider my ideas*).

There are only two minor spelling errors which do not affect comprehension or overall message (for example, *sertain, Madame*).

Grammatical structures show a high level of accuracy, with some more complex structures used including infinitive of purpose (for example, *to make people feel more safe, we can employ*) and participle clauses (for example, *Having more lighting in the park would encourage people to start using the park again*). Punctuation is accurate throughout.
