## Candidate 3

The candidate makes a good attempt at a report which has a positive effect on the reader despite some problems with coherence and errors in vocabulary use and spelling.

## Mark awarded: 11

The style and layout are appropriate for a report. The writing is cohesive and mostly coherent but is let down by a breakdown in coherence in the conclusion. The task is fully achieved with support for points made and there is a positive effect on the reader.

A range of vocabulary is used accurately, some of which is topic-specific (e.g., reduce carbon monoxide emmision (sic), accumulate, online storage). Minor vocabulary errors do not impede the message (e.g., representant, visualise / friendly to environment).

Spelling is mostly accurate, but includes some minor errors (e.g., *personel, emmision, positevely*). Punctuation is mostly accurate.

A wide range of grammatical structures are used including participle clauses (e.g., becoming more friendly) and complex structures are used accurately (e.g., Becoming paperless not only would... but also...)
