

**The candidate was given a mark of 5 because of poor accuracy in grammar and spelling and because the message is difficult to follow, even though there are valid underlying points.**

There is limited paragraphing. The underlying structure (1 – cost; 2 - who you live with; 3 - concentrating on study) is hard to identify on first reading. In terms of style, the student attempts discourse markers appropriate to an essay ('Hoever' / 'In other hand') but these can be inaccurate, and contractions are used inappropriately.

There is a reasonably wide range of vocabulary/ idiom ('attention', 'flatmates', 'trustworthy', 'supportive', 'disaster', 'complittly (sic) different experiences') but there are errors in word formation ('examins') and many spelling errors, a number of which make the message difficult to follow ('fierst'; 'to' for too; 'chip' for cheap, 'laut' for loud, 'monay', 'complittly').

There is a reasonably wide range of grammar (modals, subordination with 'if', 'so' and 'when', relative clause and gerund). However, there are many grammar mistakes: 'There will be presented various of examples'; 'the student needs give' and 'accommodation close the college' are just a few examples. Errors such as 'When do you live on to other city' and 'Parent used to be supportive even for adults children' impede communication.

Some of the punctuation is accurate but there is a missing full stop after 'success'.
