

National 5 ESOL Writing – Work

Candidate 6

The candidate was awarded 11 marks for a good attempt at the task. Although parts of the response are very strong, there are areas where ideas are not well supported, and vocabulary or grammar contain noticeable errors which detract from the overall standard.

Mark awarded: 11

Content and organisation

Writing is coherent and cohesive with a positive impact on the reader. The candidate fully achieves the task, but support is vague in places regarding the digital skills element, so this does detract from the mark in this criteria. Style and layout are wholly appropriate. There is evidence of clear structure and paragraphing.

Vocabulary and spelling

The candidate uses a wide range of vocabulary accurately and appropriately within the context of the task, such as 'consistently', 'passionate about', 'concise', 'high demand'. However, there is misuse of 'uneasy', 'toilet room', and register is inappropriate at times. There are some minor spelling errors.

Grammar and punctuation

The response contains a wide range of grammatical structures, for example, 'knew what they needed to do', 'although some of them showed...others did not...' some of the attempts at more complex structures contain errors, such as 'impossible to use it', 'which does not allow to concentrate'. Punctuation is accurate.
