

# Commentary on candidate evidence

The candidate evidence has achieved the following marks.

## Candidate 2

### Writing: Everyday Life

Identifier: 'Dear Restaurant Manager I would like...'

The candidate was awarded **8 marks**. There is a good attempt at answering the task with supported points, but the vocabulary range is merely adequate, and, despite some well used grammatical structures, punctuation is very poor throughout and creates some difficulty for the reader.

The piece fully achieves the task with support for each point made, although not always clear (9-10). Writing is generally coherent (8) but the range of cohesive devices is limited (6-7). Although there may be no evidence of paragraphing, the structure is mostly clear. (8)

The candidate uses an adequate range of vocabulary with a level of accuracy appropriate to the task 'Mixed up, problem was solved, over and undercooked'. There are some minor spelling errors. (8)

The candidate uses a reasonably wide range of grammatical structures: 'I would like to tell you' 'We were told we would get' but there are some errors (9-10). Punctuation is inaccurate throughout (0-5) – lack of full stops, capital letters, commas.
