

Commentary on candidate evidence

The candidate evidence has achieved the following marks.

Candidate 5

Writing: Work

Identifier: 'The aim of this report to make suggestions...'

The candidate was awarded **5 marks** due to a response that appears to be closer to National 3 or National 4 level response. Although there is an attempt at a formal register and the style and layout are that of a report, grammar and vocabulary are very basic for the level. Numerous mistakes impede meaning.

Lack of coherence and cohesion means the message is not conveyed on first reading. (0-5). Task may be achieved (6-7). Style and layout are mainly appropriate for the intended reader. The candidate has attempted formal writing and the piece is in a report structure. (8)

Only basic vocabulary is attempted with frequent errors. Frequent spelling errors, some of which impede communication make the report more suited to a National 3 level response. (0-5)

Grammatical structures are very limited and contain errors which at times impede communication and punctuation contains inaccuracies (0-5).
